



FR. CUTHBERT JOHNSON RIP: We are sad to announce the death of Fr. Cuthbert (Peter Johnson) who died on Monday, 16th January 2017 in Holy Cross Home, Sunderland, aged 70 years. Fr. Cuthbert joined the Benedictine Order and entered Quarr Abbey on the Isle of Wight. After leaving the Abbey, he came to our Diocese and was Priest at St. Oswalds in Bellingham, Northumberland. Fr. Cuthbert's body will be received into St. Aloysius Church, Hebburn at 4.00 pm on Wednesday, 25th January and the Requiem Mass will be at 9.30 am on Thursday, 26th January also at St. Aloysius. Fr. Cuthbert will then be buried in Hebburn Cemetery. There will be a reception in St. Aloysius Church Hall following the Mass.
