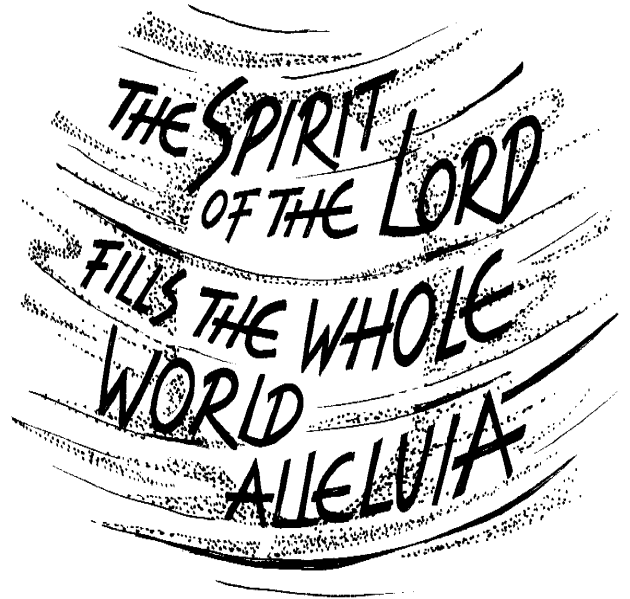

**LAY TRAINING FUND:** This work is increasing in the diocese, because of the declining number of priests. Lay parishioners will be elected as chair-persons in our parish partnerships which officially come into operation today. To support this training a second collection will be held after both masses today. We hope you can be as generous as possible. Our partnership has been named "John Ingram" (Blessed John Ingram, martyred in Gateshead in 1594 - see separate handout) and our Dean will be Fr. Paul Zielinski. Our Partnership will consist of 13 parishes and eight priests, stretching from Wardley to Whickham. Bishop Seamus has asked us all to pray for the success of this new venture. The first Partnership meeting will be held on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June at 7.00pm in St. Joseph's Hall, Gateshead. Refreshments are provided beforehand. Anyone wishing to attend, please give your name to Fr. Brendan as soon as possible.

**CYCLE OF PRAYER:** During Ordinary Time (Summer) i.e. up to September, we are asked to pray for the following intentions: A deeper understanding between Christians and Jews; Those who suffer persecution oppression and denial of Human Rights; Europe; Human Life; Seafarers.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION DAY:** Next Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June, will be First Holy Communion Day, when 12 of our schoolchildren will receive the Sacred Host for the first time. There will be a practice for this on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June, in St. Anne's Church at 6.00pm, involving the children, their parents and their catechists. Can parents please ensure that the children making their First Holy Communion are in Church by 10.00 am on Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> June. Please remember to pray for the children and their families on their special day.

**HALF – DAY RETREAT:** A half-day Retreat with Prayer and Reflection will be held in St. Anne's Church on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June. This will be led by Sister Michael, Sisters of Mercy from Seaham and will begin after 10.00am Mass at approx. 11.00am until 3.00pm. Please bring packed lunch. Tea and coffee will be provided. **DIOCESAN WEBSITE:** Hopefully, you will be aware of the intention to celebrate the formation of our new 18 Partnerships this weekend. There will be a Pastoral Letter from Bishop Seamus and a 'Prayer for our New Partnerships' written by Fr. Adrian Dixon, read at all Masses. The Directory section of the Diocesan website will reflect the changes with parishes being shown as part of their Partnership and Episcopal Area and maps of the Partnership being provided. Over the next few weeks further changes will take place to establish a 'Partnership Area' on the Diocesan website, where various information and guidelines will be posted.

**FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI:** On Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> June we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi when all Eucharistic Ministers will renew their commitment to Eucharistic service during the Vigil Mass. We ask all Ministers to try to attend Mass in their home parishes to avoid having to renew their commitment at a later date. There will be a meeting for all Eucharistic Ministers after 10.30 am Mass on Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> June. We hope that as many Ministers as possible will be able to attend this meeting.

**DIOCESAN FESTIVAL:** Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017, Emmaus Youth Village, Consett. This year's theme is "Changing Hearts: The Challenge of Discipleship". There will be talks from David Wells and Sr. Judith Russi. It includes prayer, liturgy, reflection, mime, discussion and music. It is an opportunity for our whole Diocesan family to come together to celebrate and to be encouraged in our faith, offering inspiring speakers for adults as well as activities for young people and children.
