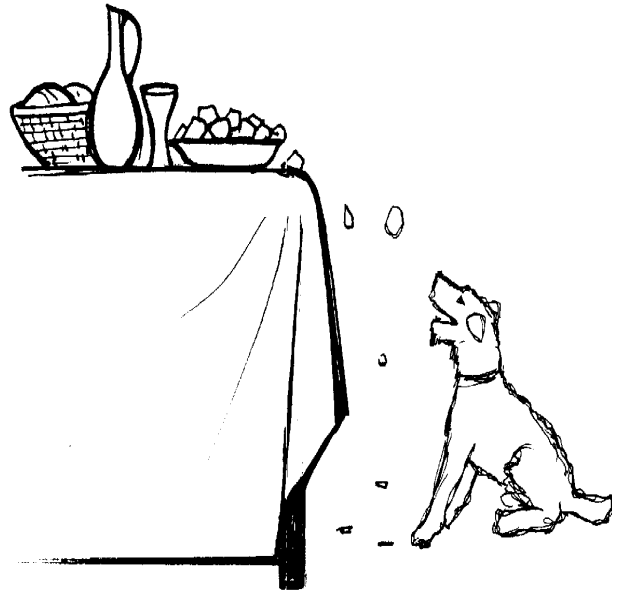

Michael was ordained in St. Mary's, Newton Aycliffe, in 1979 and has served in a number of parishes in the diocese. He has also served as Chaplain & Vocations Director for the Apostleship of the Sea and was a lecturer at Ushaw College. Fr. Michael's Requiem Mass will be held on Thursday, 24th August 2017 at 12 noon in St. Mary's, Forest Hall, followed by cremation at West Road Crematorium, Newcastle. Please remember Fr. Michael in your prayers. May he rest in peace.
