

ARCHBISHOP OSCAR ROMERO: To mark the occasion of the canonisation of Archbishop Oscar Romero in Rome in October, Bishop Seamus will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving on Saturday, 13th October, at 11.00am, in St Mary's Cathedral, Newcastle. Everyone welcome. Archbishop Romero was assassinated in 1980, while offering Mass in San Salvador. He embraced a simple lifestyle; he was a popular preacher and responded with real compassion to the plight of the poor.
