Pilgrimage to Lourdes for those needing Nursing Care

Our diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes, from 26th July – 2nd August still has several places available for those who need Nursing Care or who are unable to travel or stay in Lourdes on their own. Flights are from Newcastle, directly to Lourdes, Accommodation will be in the Accueil Marie St Frai and there will be the assistance of the pilgrimage nurses and doctors throughout the week in Lourdes as well as many helpers. The cost for those staying in the

Accueil is £895.00 per person. A medical assessment will be made to make sure the pilgrimage can offer the appropriate care. Closing date for application is 21st April 2019.

FRIDAY A DAY OF PRAYER FOR VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE IN THE CHURCH

The Bishops' Conference has designated the Friday of the Fifth Week of Lent as a day of prayer for the Victims and survivors of Sexual abuse in the Church. The Liturgy Office, the Marriage and Family Life Department, CSAS and the NCSC have prepared a suite of reflections, prayers and other liturgical materials for use on this day.

THE JOHN INGRAM PARTNERSHIP FINANCE COMMITTEE

Last Wednesday it elected Roger Eley (St Anne's) as Chair and Craig Simpson (St Oswald's) as Secretary. The meeting also reached agreement to fund the running costs for **Joe's Place**, which provides at St Joseph's Parish Centre meals for the homeless every Wednesday, and also to fund the Bus that takes young people from Cardinal Hume four times a year to "The Source" Youth Event at the Cathedral. Each parish will contribute 2% of ordinary annual income to fund the Partnership Bank Account, after discussion at individual Parish Finance Committee level to approve the same. After initial contributions of £100 from each church last year, the current total amount in the Partnership fund stands at £1,326.
