King Richard I of England placed his crusading army under his protection and in 1222 his feast was proclaimed a holiday.

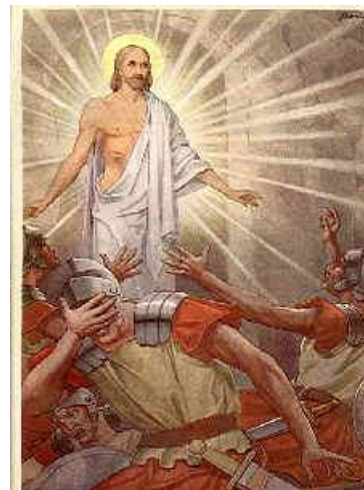
