HELPING WITH THE DIOCESAN LEVY

Every parish is obliged to pay funds into the Central Services of the Diocese to cover the essential support departments, Education, Liturgy, Property, Safeguarding, Finance and the Bishop's Office. St Anne's this year will have to pay in four quarterly instalments a total of £3,790. The amount is calculated as a percentage of the parish's Offertory Income.
