Wednesday 24th July at 7.00 pm there will be a special Mass to celebrate the Martyrs of our Diocese, which includes the priest John Ingram. The priests and parishioners from the 13 Catholic churches in Gateshead will gather at St Joseph's Gateshead for this Mass, and there will be an opportunity to mingle and chat afterwards over some light refreshments. The John Ingram Walk takes place on Sunday 28th July, concluding at St Edmund's on Gateshead Hight Street at about 3.30 pm.
