**THE JOHN INGRAM WALK**

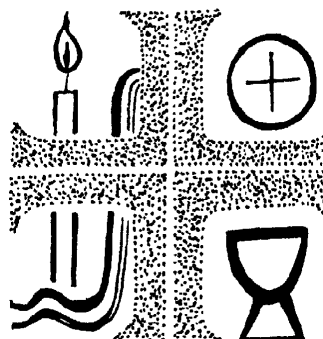

**THE MARTYRS OF THE DIOCESE**

Of the 315 of our Catholic ancestors who sacrificed their lives religious persecution of the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries, 28 can be considered 'Martyrs of the North', as they were born, laboured or suffered within the confines of Northumberland and Durham. To return to England as a priest was high treason punishable by hanging, drawing and quartering; to shelter a priest was a felony punishable by imprisonment, fines, confiscation of property and in many cases, death. It was only heroes and heroines who could face such ordeals – these are our martyrs, including our own blessed John Ingram, the Gateshead martyr.
