THE MARTYRS OF THE DIOCESE Of the 315 of our Catholic ancestors who

Of the 315 of our Catholic ancestors who sacrificed their lives religious persecution of the 16th and 17th centuries, 28 can be considered 'Martyrs of the North', as they were born, laboured or suffered within the confines of Northumberland and Durham. To return to England as a priest was high treason punishable by hanging, drawing and quartering; to shelter a priest was a felony punishable by imprisonment, fines, confiscation of property and in many cases, death. It was only heroes and heroines who could face such ordeals – these are our martyrs, including our own blessed John Ingram, the Gateshead martyr.
