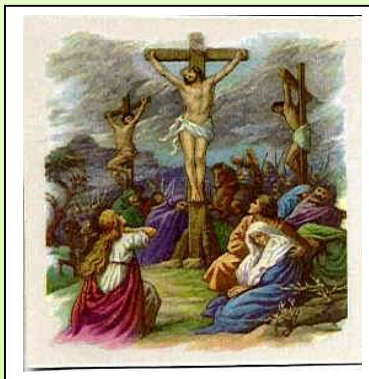

GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT.

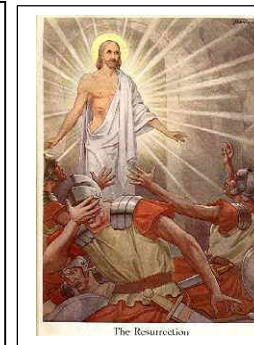
