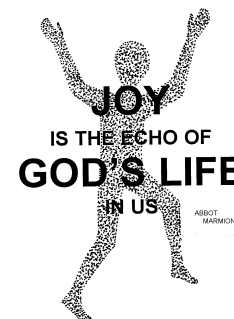

Donations can be made by clicking the 'Donate' tab at the top of the Diocesan website [homepage](http://diocesehn.org.uk/). From this Donations page, donors can choose to donate to one of the featured Projects, or can scroll down to find the parish they'd like to donate to.

They can also search for their parish using the 'Search for a location' field at the top of the list of parishes. When they find their chosen parish, they just need to click on the 'Donate' button and then choose one of the suggested amounts or enter the amount they would like to donate.

They can choose to make a single donation, but can also set up a weekly or monthly donation if they'd like to, and can Gift Aid their donations simply by turning on the 'I would like to Gift Aid this donation' button.
