Whether you're eight years old or in our eighties, at some point in your life you've probably struggled with the question, "Why do we have to go to Mass?" You just may not feel like going at times. You may not like the music or the homilies in your parish. You may think that Mass is boring. You may think that Mass is boring. You may try to convince yourself that you can pray just as well outdoors or in the comfort of your own home. THE POWER OF NEGATIVE THINKING Even though you know that going to Mass is a good thing, you can talk yourself out of going by focussing on the negatives. At first you may feel a little guilty, but eventually, you can justify your decision by convincing yourself that you are too busy, too tired, too bored, or too frustrated. When that happens, you miss the great gift that God gives to us in the Eucharist. THINKING POSITIVELY. Research studies show that people who go to church every week are: Less likely to abuse drugs and alcohol. More likely to live longer and a happier life. MORE THAN ENTERTAINMENT When entertainment is the model for church worship services, the leaders try to induce particular feelings in the audience. The Mass, however, is just the opposite. It is a ritual in which people bring their own feelings and incorporate them into the liturgy. That's why it is possible for two people to attend Mass, one grieving a death and the other celebrating a birth, yet both feel connected. The whole point is to go beyond feelings into authentic prayer, which is the offering of oneself to God in Jesus Christ.
