10 MILLION

On 23 September 2022, at 11:41am, thousands of people across the United Kingdom stopped for a minute of silence to commemorate the ten million lives that have been lost to abortion in England, Wales and Scotland since the Abortion Act was introduced in 1967.
It is projected that the ten millionth baby had their life ended by abortion at 11:41am on Friday 23 September.

The minute of silence took place to coincide with the tragic ending of this baby's life and to also remember the other 9,999,999 lives that have been lost to abortion across England, Scotland and Wales.
Following the minute of silence, Right To Life UK released a short two-minute video called *The Ten Million*, which commemorates the ten million people who have had their lives ended through abortion and attempts to illustrate what the UK has lost through the death of these millions of people.
