Under 18 years of age marriage is now prohibited in UK Law

The Marriage and Civil Partnership (Minimum Age) Act 2022 was passed by the UK Government on 28th April 2022. The Act comes into force on Monday 27th February 2023. The Act will raise the age of marriage and civil partnership to 18 years in England and Wales to protect children from the scourge of forced marriage. This means that 16 to 17-year-olds will no longer be able to marry or enter a civil partnership under any circumstances, including with parental or judicial consent. It will not be possible for anyone under 18 years of age to marry or enter a civil partnership after this date.
