St Bede the Venerable. Priest and Doctor of the Church. 673 - 735

Thursday is the feast of St Bede the Venerable. Born at Wearmouth in 673, Bede was educated at the monasteries of Wearmouth and Jarrow, where he was professed by St Benet Biscop and later ordained by St John of Beverley. He remained there as a monk for the rest of his life. He was the first historian of the English church and people, a master of the Scriptures and of the teachings of the Fathers. Known for his delight in learning, teaching and writing, he is venerated as the 'light of the Church' in the period sometimes known as the Dark Ages, and as a forerunner of the 8th and 9th century renaissance of the Western Church. Bede died at Jarrow on 25 May in 735.
