LITURGICAL CHANGES

In recent months there has been a number of new instructions/rules regarding the celebration of holy Mass from the Dicastery for Divine Worship in Rome, in particular with regard to the Traditional Latin Mass. In the light of these instructions, Father Paul has decided to return to facing the congregation (*'versus ad populum'*) during the Offertory and Eucharistic Prayer, even though *'ad orientem'* (facing the Tabernacle) has always been and continues to be a legitimate option for priests today, having been for good reasons the venerable practice for over 1,000 years.
