THE COST OF VANDALISM AND PREVENTION MEASURES AT ST AUGUSTINE'S CHURCH

The cost of repairing the six windows (leaded lights) at St Augustine's church after the recent outbreak of vandalism is £1.320 plus VAT, making a total cost of £1.650. This will be covered by our building's insurance, but we must pay the first £350 of the insurance claim.

The cost of protecting the 34 windows at the lower level against any possible future damage with strong long-lasting polycarbonate sheets is £2,950 for materials, £590 for VAT, making a **total cost of £3,540**.

This work has now been completed and is not covered by insurance. It must be paid for in full out of parish funds. Any donations (anonymous or otherwise) to help defray these substantial costs would be most welcome.
