

CHURCH ORGAN 2024 RESTORATION PRJECT COSTS

St Augustine's Pipe Organ is 70 years old (installed in 1962 when the church was opened) and has developed major problems, requiring the work of experts to mend. Bellows and sound parts connected to the pipes will need to be taken away to the workshop for repairs and refurbishment.

The written Estimate from John Lightbown & Sons, Organ Builders Ltd., has now been received. Swell and Great under actions restored. Pedal actions restored etc: Cost including materials is £12,700 excluding VAT. Bellows Reservoir double rise repairs.
