At Joe's Place this week the menu was:

Scrambled eggs on toast, tuna bake pasta , 122 toasties with a variety of fillings, rice pudding, fruit mousse, cake and custard. We used 72 eggs, 2kg of pasta, 15 tins of tuna, 10 tins of tomatoes, 1kg of cheese, 4 bags of onions, 17 loaves of bread, 4 tins of corned beef, 4 tins of ham, 100 slices of cheese, 12 tins of rice pudding, 29 fruit mouses, 5 cakes, 10 packs of custard plus milk, butter, salad, bananas and oranges. . 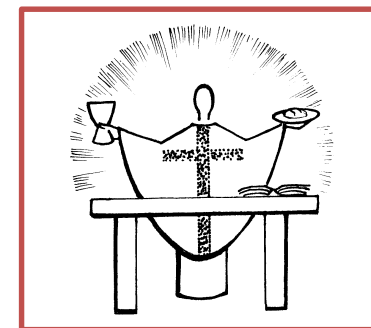
