**FOOD COOP** Dear Supporters. This week 47 families/couples and 64 people collected food at the Food Co-op (129 adults and 81 children). Donations were received from several local churches, alternative food bank provision and individual supporters. Many thanks for all the donations and thanks to those who deliver them to Corpus Christi in time for the Food Co-op. With many children attending with their parents it was a busy session, especially in the tea, coffee, biscuits and sandwiches area.

Several of the volunteers brought their children with them, who sat and occupied themselves for the session. We are most grateful to the volunteers and their families for continuing their commitment in the school holidays. It would be impossible without them, with their multiple language skills and their energy and enthusiasm.

Following the events of the weekend and the ongoing news of violent disorder in other areas of the UK, it was a concern as to whether members of the Asylum and Refugee Community (ARC) would attend the Food Co-op this week. However, we were pleased that people came, and many were prepared to discuss what was going on. Several expressed their fears and were bewildered as to what was happening. It was reassuring that we could continue to support the ARC in Bensham during this troubled time.
