Let us keep in our prayers our sisters and brothers from the asylum and refugee community in Gateshead and the Northeast who are very anxious at this time.

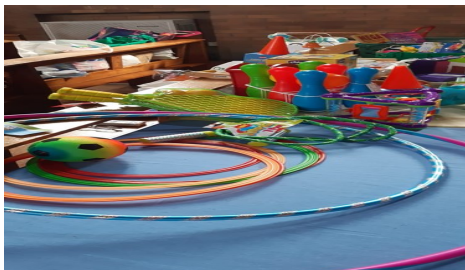
FOOD COOP

Dear Supporters, Week 4 of the school holidays saw a very steady session with 50 families/couples and 53 single people collecting food (144 adults and 82 children). The refreshment area was busy with many people staying for a cuppa and a chat.

Donations were received from several local churches, individual supporters and a local care home. All were gratefully received. A member of a nearby allotment called in after seeing the queue. She was just passing and had a surplus of courgettes in her car boot looking for a home. She was very pleased to donate them and left with the promise of more fresh vegetables next week. Fareshare brought a variety of fresh produce including peppers, pak choi, runner beans and mushrooms. All members left with a good choice of fresh and tinned foods.

Today the small toys were distributed with children being provided with an item of their choice. Children left clutching treasures and were very happy. Many thanks to all who have donated these items enabling all children to receive a gift.

This week's menu was: scrambled eggs on toast, hot dog in a bun with chips and baked beans, toasties with a variety of fillings, ice cream and fruit, cake and custard, as well as fresh fruit and salad. We served 32 scrambled eggs on toast, 66 hot dog dinners, 64 toasties, 23 cakes with custard and 46 ice cream and fruit desserts

We used 64 eggs, 10 tins of hot dogs, 2 kilos of frozen chips, 14 tins of baked beans, 66 buns, 4 tins of corned beef, 4 tins of ham, 2 tins of tuna, 60 cheese slices, 8 loaves of bread, 2 large cakes, 8 tins /packets of custard, 12 tins of fruit, 4 large tubs of ice cream as well as cheese, butter and milk.

We are always grateful for your donations and this week we particularly need tins of ham, mince and tinned fruit. Please leave your donations in the church porch or in the box provided.
