This week 67 families/couples and 25 single persons attended the Food Co-op (144 adults and 126 children). This busy session was the first of the school term, with some parents attending with pre school children.

There was a very good supply of fresh fruit and vegetables and store cupboard items available, thanks to generous donations from various churches, individual supporters and funding through the Household Support Fund, which were all very welcome. The refreshments were also well received by those attending.

Despite the demands of the first day back 16 volunteers turned up to help enabling the sessions to run smoothly.
