Toiletries for Christmas Project

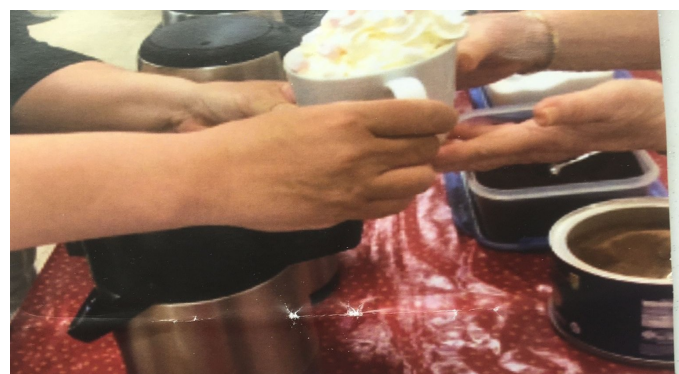

FOOD COOP Dear Supporters,

After a two-week break, the Food Co-op was open as usual today. One hundred and five people, representing 59 families /couples and 46 single people (153 adults and 103 children) chose and collected food. Many stopped for refreshments and made good use of the opportunity to sit and chat. Donations were received from several local churches, a primary school, Saltwell Park Run and individual supporters. The allocation from Fairshare included red cabbage, courgettes and broccoli enabling all members to have a good choice of fresh, tinned and dried foods. Many thanks for all the donations received and thanks to those who deliver them in time for the session on Tuesday.

This week we met several new families who have been recently accommodated in our community. With having such a range of languages spoken by the volunteers, new members are routinely guided by someone with a common language hopefully making them feel welcome.
